- B. Brian Skidmore covered previously
- C. Keith reported Hill Studios came to measure Bailey-Robbins and Creech buildings to begin feasibility study and discussed the business center here. We will try to obtain a \$25,000 planning grant. Building use is a step toward grant for housing. We had an old Massey-Ferguson tractor down earlier this year. Vocational school took it for practice and fixed it asking only for parts and service supplies only.
- 10. Sidewalk Safety Project-VDOT still reviewing bids in the Bristol District. One more easement to obtain. Owner wants to sell, Greg said we could push eminent domain.
- 11. Town Attorney- EDA wants to restart Chamber of Commerce for business, tourism. We need our planning commission together to look at zoning. Jeff Martin and Loretta See need sworn in.
- 12. Council Reports:
- Gary McElyea asked about current COVID regulations? Governor has issued that all state employees test weekly if not vaccinated. Keith said VML thinks more will come out on that and recommendations are for masks but only mandated for schools. Jill Carson stated there is a big difference between Northern VA with 77% vaccinated and 20 +% in SW VA.
- Terry Pope has had several people brag about the town's look, flowers, and our efforts. He would like to find out if we can now eliminate overhead lines and would the infrastructure money pay for burying them? Brian said large structures with overhead lines attached make it hard to use ladder truck during a fire. Terry would also like to recognize older businesses on our media. Jeff Martin questioned why we have not. The planning commission needs to meet on some of the blighted properties in town and address Old Mill apartment building. It was also noted, all available buildings for business in town are rented.
- 13. Closed session- At 7:02 PM, Terry Pope made a Motion to go into executive session pursuant to: § 2.2-3711(A)(1): Personnel. Provides an exemption for:

Discussion, consideration, or interviews of prospective candidates for employment; assignment, appointment, promotion, performance, demotion, salaries, disciplining, or resignation of specific public officers, appointees, or employees of any public body; and evaluation of performance of departments or schools of public institutions of higher education where such evaluation will necessarily involve discussion of the performance of specific individuals. Any teacher shall be permitted to be present during a closed meeting in which there is a discussion or consideration of a disciplinary matter that involves the teacher and some student and the student involved in the matter is present, provided the teacher makes a written request to be present to the presiding officer of the appropriate board. Nothing in this subdivision, however, shall be construed to authorize a closed meeting by a local governing body or an elected school board to discuss compensation matters that affect the membership of such body or board collectively.

§ 2.2-3711(A)(3): Acquisition & disposition of property. Provides an exemption for:

Discussion or consideration of the acquisition of real property for a public purpose, or of the disposition of publicly held real property, where discussion in an open meeting would adversely affect the bargaining position or negotiating strategy of the public body.

Virginia Code Section 2.2-3711(A)(5) Discussion concerning a prospective business or industry or the expansion of an existing business or industry where no previous announcement has been made of the business' or industry's interest in locating or expanding its facilities in the community.

Virginia Code Section 2.2-3711(A)(6) Discussion or consideration of the investment of public funds where competition or bargaining is involved, where, if made public initially, the financial interest of the governmental unit would be adversely affected.
